NON PROFIT RULES AND REGULATIONS
Non-profits and community outreach will be assigned individually, and should be reserved in order to be added to the market calendar of events. Non-profits with a strong membership base or involvement in Charleston and those with educational outreach related to sustainability, community and health will be prioritized. The Market will provide an 8x8 or 10'x10' canopy. Participants must provide their own booth display and garbage disposal. If accepted to be a non-profit at the CFM, the CFM manager will give you specific set up and break down rules. Fundraising efforts (such as raffle tickets, and t-shirt sales) is not allowed at the Charleston Farmers Market.
There is no application or booth fee but full participation in set up and breakdown is expected. Certain groups, particularly those with a closely related educational outreach theme may sign up for repeat visits during the season.
