NFP and community outreach will be assigned individually and should be reserved in order to be added to the market calendar of events. NFP with a strong membership base or involvement in Charleston and those with educational outreach related to sustainability, community and health will be prioritized. The CFM will provide an 8'x 8' or 10'x 10' canopy upon request at no charge. Participants must provide their own booth display and garbage disposal. If accepted to be a NFP at the CFM, CFM Management will give you specific instructions for set up and break down procedures. **Fundraising efforts must be approved in advance by CFM Management.**

There is no application or booth fee but, full cooperation with CFM Operation Guidelines is expected. Certain groups, particularly those with a closely related educational outreach theme may sign up for repeat visits during the season.
